

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 826

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, after line 42, insert:

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3 **“FISCAL PROVISIONS**

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5 **“SECTION 12. (1) On or before January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the Oregon De-**
6 **partment of Emergency Management shall estimate the expenses the department will incur**
7 **in the biennium beginning July 1 of the same year to carry out the provisions of ORS 403.450,**
8 **403.455, 403.460 and 403.465 and section 1, chapter 825, Oregon Laws 2005. The department**
9 **shall report the estimate to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and the**
10 **Legislative Fiscal Officer.**

11 **“(2) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall charge an assessment to**
12 **each public body in state government so as to recoup the costs estimated under subsection**
13 **(1) of this section. Each public body in state government shall pay to the credit of the de-**
14 **partment the amount the public body was assessed under this subsection as an administra-**
15 **tive expense from funds or appropriations available to the public body in the same manner**
16 **as other claims against the public body are paid.**

17 **“(3) The department shall adopt rules specifying the method for allocating the expenses**
18 **described in subsection (1) of this section among public bodies in state government and for**
19 **collecting the assessments described in this section. The department shall deposit assess-**
20 **ments collected under this section into the Statewide Interoperability Fund established under**
21 **section 13 of this 2025 Act.**

22 **“(4) As used in this section:**

23 **“(a) ‘Public body’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.**

24 **“(b) ‘State government’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.111.**

25 **“SECTION 13. The Statewide Interoperability Fund is established in the State Treasury,**
26 **separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Statewide Interoper-**
27 **ability Fund must be credited to the fund. The fund consists of moneys deposited in the fund**
28 **under section 12 of this 2025 Act and may include moneys appropriated, allocated, deposited**
29 **or transferred to the fund by the Legislative Assembly or otherwise and interest earned on**
30 **moneys in the fund. The moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon**
31 **Department of Emergency Management to carry out the provisions of ORS 403.450, 403.455,**
32 **403.460 and 403.465 and section 1, chapter 825, Oregon Laws 2005.**

33 **“SECTION 14. Notwithstanding the deadline specified in section 12 (1) of this 2025 Act,**
34 **the Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall make the estimate required under**
35 **section 12 of this 2025 Act for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, on or before July 1,**

1 **2025.”.**

2 On page 6, line 1, delete “12” and insert “15”.

3 In line 7, delete “13” and insert “16”.

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
