

# Senate Bill 870

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Tina Kotek for Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes the home address and phone number of some OLCC permittees exempt from public disclosure. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Exempts from public records disclosure the residential address and personal phone number of an individual who holds a specified permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475C.517 is amended to read:

6 475C.517. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, information is exempt from public disclo-  
7 sure under ORS 192.311 to 192.478 if the information is:

8 (a) The address of a premises for which a license has been issued or for which an applicant has  
9 proposed licensure under ORS 475C.065, 475C.085, 475C.093 or 475C.548;

10 (b) Related to the security plan or the operational plan for a premises for which a license has  
11 been issued or for which an applicant has proposed licensure under ORS 475C.005 to 475C.525 or  
12 475C.548; [*or*]

13 (c) Related to any record that the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission determines contains  
14 proprietary information of a licensee[.]; **or**

15 **(d) The residential address or personal phone number of an individual who holds a permit**  
16 **issued under ORS 475C.273.**

17 (2) The exemption from public disclosure as provided by this section does not apply to a request  
18 for information if the request is made by a law enforcement agency.
