Senate Bill 888

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Bans a local government from banning or limiting in homes the use of natural gas. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Prohibits local governments from prohibiting or limiting the residential use of natural gas as an energy source. Provides for certain exceptions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the use of natural gas as an energy source.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A unit of local government may not adopt or enforce any ordinance, rule

5 or regulation or take any other actions that prohibit or limit the residential use of natural 6 gas as an energy source.

7 (2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section shall limit the authority of a local govern-8 ment to adopt or enforce a local ordinance, rule or regulation or take other actions strictly 9 necessary to comply with:

(a) The Uniform Building Code published by the International Conference of Building
Officials, as amended and adopted by the Director of the Department of Consumer and
Business Services;
