

Senate Bill 895

Sponsored by Senator BONHAM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that an agency has to come before a committee to talk about a rule if 10 members request it in writing. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.6).

Requires an agency, upon the written request of 10 members of the Legislative Assembly objecting to a rule, to appear before an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly for a hearing on the rule.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 183.**

5 **SECTION 2. Upon the written request of 10 members of the Legislative Assembly sub-**
6 **mitted to the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives ob-**
7 **jecting to any rule adopted by an agency, the agency shall appear before an appropriate**
8 **committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly for a hearing on the rule.**
