

Senate Bill 920

Sponsored by Senator BONHAM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the OSU Extension Service to oversee a project to improve mental health and SUD services in this state. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.6).

Directs the Oregon State University Extension Service to oversee a project to accelerate the promotion of behavioral health in Oregon.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Oregon State University Extension Service oversight of behavioral health promotion;
3 and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. The Oregon State University Extension Service shall oversee a project to**
6 **accelerate the promotion of behavioral health in Oregon by:**

7 (1) **Convening local committees from across the behavioral health sector to develop a**
8 **plan to promote behavioral health;**

9 (2) **Facilitating community conversations about mental health and substance use; and**

10 (3) **Contributing to any follow-up actions taken by counties or regions that choose to**
11 **participate in the project.**

12 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
13 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**
14 **on its passage.**
