CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to foster children.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.

**SECTION 2.** Medical assistance shall be provided to an individual who:

(1) Is at least 18 years of age and not older than 25 years of age;

(2) Resides in this state;

(3) Was in foster care in the custody of any state on the date the individual attained 18 years of age; and

(4) Was enrolled in medical assistance in this state or another state while in foster care.

**SECTION 3.** The Oregon Health Authority shall seek federal approval to secure the receipt of federal financial participation in the costs of providing medical assistance to individuals described in section 2 of this 2025 Act who were in foster care in another state.
