## Senate Bill 997

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Exempts the siting of a power plant that uses one or more small modular reactors from the law that requires there to be a place for radioactive waste to be disposed of before a nuclear power plant may be sited in this state. Refers the Act to the people for their approval or rejection. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.3).

Allows the site of the state of the state

there be a licensed repository for the disposal of high-level radioactive waste.

Refers the Act to the people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 469.590 to
6	469.601.
7	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:
8	(a) "Small modular reactor" means an advanced nuclear reactor:
9	(A) With a nameplate capacity of 300 electrical megawatts or less;
10	(B) That is made up of components that are factory fabricated and transported to lo
11	cation for on-site assembly; and
12	(C) That may be constructed and operated in combination with similar reactors at a
13	single site.
14	(b) "Small modular reactor energy facility" means an energy facility that produces power
15	from using one or more small modular reactors at a single site.
16	(2) ORS 469.595 and 469.599 do not apply to a small modular reactor energy facility.
17	SECTION 3. This 2025 Act shall be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection
18	at the next regular general election held throughout this state.
