PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3198

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Health Authority shall dedicate staff in
the office of the authority that is responsible for tribal affairs to lead
the work of addressing the issue of missing and murdered indigenous
people. The dedicated staff shall:

6 "(1) Provide victim services, outreach, education and prevention
7 services related to missing and murdered indigenous people.

"(2) Collaborate with and support the development of interagency 8 agreements with tribal governments, native-led organizations, local, 9 state and federal law enforcement agencies and community leaders 10 providing services related to missing and murdered indigenous people. 11 "(3) Collaborate with partners to develop and maintain data on 12 missing and murdered indigenous people in this state to identify pat-13 terns and inform targeted health interventions and violence pre-14 15vention programs.

16 "(4) Collaborate with representatives of the nine federally recog-17 nized tribes in Oregon, community-based organizations and urban-18 based American Indian and Alaska Native populations to implement 19 community education programs and support youth engagement initi-20 atives to reduce vulnerabilities that disproportionately impact 21 indigenous people. "(5) Strengthen partnerships between law enforcement and tribal
and urban American Indian and Alaska Native communities.".
