**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3198**

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall dedicate staff in**
3 **the office of the authority that is responsible for tribal affairs to lead**
4 **the work of addressing the issue of missing and murdered indigenous**
5 **people. The dedicated staff shall:**

6 **“(1) Provide victim services, outreach, education and prevention**
7 **services related to missing and murdered indigenous people.**

8 **“(2) Collaborate with and support the development of interagency**
9 **agreements with tribal governments, native-led organizations, local,**
10 **state and federal law enforcement agencies and community leaders**
11 **providing services related to missing and murdered indigenous people.**

12 **“(3) Collaborate with partners to develop and maintain data on**
13 **missing and murdered indigenous people in this state to identify pat-**
14 **terns and inform targeted health interventions and violence pre-**
15 **vention programs.**

16 **“(4) Collaborate with representatives of the nine federally recog-**
17 **nized tribes in Oregon, community-based organizations and urban-**
18 **based American Indian and Alaska Native populations to implement**
19 **community education programs and support youth engagement initi-**
20 **atives to reduce vulnerabilities that disproportionately impact**
21 **indigenous people.**

1 **“(5) Strengthen partnerships between law enforcement and tribal**
2 **and urban American Indian and Alaska Native communities.”.**
