- "SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall dedicate staff in 2 the office of the authority that is responsible for tribal affairs to lead 3 the work of addressing the issue of missing and murdered indigenous
- people. The dedicated staff shall: 5

- "(1) Provide victim services, outreach, education and prevention 6 services related to missing and murdered indigenous people. 7
- "(2) Collaborate with and support the development of interagency 8 agreements with tribal governments, native-led organizations, local, state and federal law enforcement agencies and community leaders providing services related to missing and murdered indigenous people.
  - "(3) Collaborate with partners to develop and maintain data on missing and murdered indigenous people in this state to identify patterns and inform targeted health interventions and violence prevention programs.
- "(4) Collaborate with representatives of the nine federally recog-16 nized tribes in Oregon, community-based organizations and urban-17 based American Indian and Alaska Native populations to implement 18 community education programs and support youth engagement initi-19 atives to reduce vulnerabilities that disproportionately impact 20 indigenous people. 21

"(5) Strengthen partnerships between law enforcement and tribal and urban American Indian and Alaska Native communities.".
