**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 300**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “prescribing an effective
2 date” and insert “declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 181A.840 is amended to read:

5 “181A.840. As used in ORS 181A.360, 181A.840 to 181A.918, 181A.895 and
6 181A.995:

7 “(1) ‘Certification’ means recognition by the Department of Public Safety
8 Standards and Training that a private security professional meets all of the
9 qualifications listed in ORS 181A.855.

10 “(2) ‘Executive manager’ means a person:

11 “(a) Who is authorized to act on behalf of a company or business in
12 matters of licensure and certification;

13 “(b) Who is authorized to hire and terminate personnel;

14 “(c) Whose primary responsibility is the management of certified private
15 security professionals; and

16 “(d) Who has final responsibility for a company’s or business’s compliance
17 with ORS 181A.840 to 181A.918.

18 “(3) ‘Instructor’ means any person who has been certified by the depart-
19 ment as meeting the requirements to provide instruction to private security
20 providers or applicants.

21 “(4) ‘License’ means recognition by the department that an executive

1 manager or supervisory manager meets the requirements adopted by the
2 Board on Public Safety Standards and Training as necessary to provide pri-
3 vate security services.

4 “(5) ‘Primary responsibility’ means an activity that is fundamental to, and
5 required or expected in, the regular course of employment and is not merely
6 incidental to employment.

7 “(6)(a) ‘Private security entity’ [*means a person engaged in the business*
8 *of providing private security that:*]

9 “[*(A) Employs private security providers; or*]

10 “[*(B) Contracts or subcontracts with an existing licensed private security*
11 *entity to provide private security services.*] **includes any person that:**

12 **“(A) For an agreed remuneration or rate of pay, recruits, solicits,**
13 **supplies or employs workers to perform labor or provide services for**
14 **another person that include private security services;**

15 **“(B) For an agreed remuneration or rate of pay, recruits, solicits,**
16 **supplies or employs workers on behalf of another employer to provide**
17 **services that include private security services; or**

18 **“(C) Enters into a subcontract with another person to perform any**
19 **of the activities described in subparagraph (A) or (B) of this para-**
20 **graph.**

21 “(b) ‘Private security entity’ does not include a special campus security
22 provider commissioned under ORS 352.118 or a private security provider on
23 a campus of an institution of higher education regulated under ORS
24 181A.972.

25 “(7) ‘Private security professional’ means an individual who performs, as
26 the individual’s primary responsibility, private security services for consid-
27 eration, regardless of whether the individual, while performing the private
28 security services, is armed or unarmed or wears a uniform or plain clothes,
29 and regardless of whether the individual is employed part-time or full-time
30 to perform private security services.

1 “(8) ‘Private security provider’ means any individual who performs the
2 functions of a private security professional, executive manager, supervisory
3 manager or instructor.

4 “(9) ‘Private security services’ means the performance of at least one of
5 the following activities:

6 “(a) Observing and reporting unlawful activity.

7 “(b) Preventing or detecting theft or misappropriation of goods, money
8 or other items of value.

9 “(c) Protecting individuals or property, including but not limited to pro-
10 prietary information, from harm or misappropriation.

11 “(d) Controlling access to premises being protected or, with respect to a
12 licensee of the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission, controlling access
13 to premises at an entry to the premises or any portion of the premises where
14 minors are prohibited.

15 “(e) Securely moving prisoners.

16 “(f) Taking enforcement action by detaining persons or placing persons
17 under arrest under ORS 133.225.

18 “(g) Providing canine services for guarding premises or for detecting un-
19 lawful devices or substances.

20 “(10) ‘Supervisory manager’ means an employee of or a person supervised
21 by an executive manager who has as a primary responsibility the supervision
22 of certified private security professionals.

23 **“SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**
24 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
25 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
