**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2232**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “821.030” insert “and 821.220”.

2 After line 17, insert:

3 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 821.220 is amended to read:

4 “821.220. (1) A person commits the offense of operating an improperly
5 equipped all-terrain vehicle if the person operates any all-terrain vehicle
6 without the following equipment:

7 “(a) An adequate braking device that may be operated either by hand or
8 foot.

9 “(b) An adequate and operating muffling device that shall be maintained
10 in good working order and in constant operation and shall effectively blend
11 the exhaust and motor noise in such a manner so as to comply with all ap-
12 plicable noise emission standards established by the [*Department of Envi-*
13 *ronmental Quality*] **State Parks and Recreation Department.**

14 “(2) The department [*of Environmental Quality*] shall establish procedures
15 for testing of noise levels consistent with this section.

16 “(3) All-terrain vehicles used in organized racing events in an area des-
17 ignated for that purpose shall comply with the motor sports vehicles and
18 facilities regulations of the department [*of Environmental Quality*].

19 “(4) In addition to other penalties provided by this section, the owner or
20 operator of an all-terrain vehicle may be liable as provided under ORS
21 821.310.
