On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 30, insert:

but does not meet or cannot present evidence of strict compliance with the

5 requirements of subsection (1)(d) of this section, the board may allow some

6 of the applicant's education or experience to substitute one for the other.

7 However, this subsection does not allow a waiver of, or substitution for, any

8 qualifications needed for a certified tax aide certificate other than those de-

9 scribed in subsection (1)(d) of this section.".
