**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 826**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, after line 42 insert:

3 **“FISCAL PROVISIONS**

4
5 **“SECTION 12. (1) On or before January 1 of each odd-numbered**
6 **year, the Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall esti-**
7 **mate the expenses the department will incur in the biennium begin-**
8 **ning July 1 of the same year to carry out the provisions of ORS 403.450,**
9 **403.455, 403.460 and 403.465 and section 1, chapter 825, Oregon Laws**
10 **2005. The department shall report the estimate to the Oregon Depart-**
11 **ment of Administrative Services and the Legislative Fiscal Officer.**

12 **“(2) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall**
13 **charge an assessment to each public body in state government so as**
14 **to recoup the costs estimated under subsection (1) of this section.**
15 **Each public body in state government shall pay to the credit of the**
16 **department the amount the public body was assessed under this sub-**
17 **section as an administrative expense from funds or appropriations**
18 **available to the public body in the same manner as other claims**
19 **against the public body are paid.**

20 **“(3) The department shall adopt rules specifying the method for al-**
21 **locating the expenses described in subsection (1) of this section among**

1 public bodies in state government and for collecting the assessments
2 described in this section. The department shall deposit assessments
3 collected under this section into the Statewide Interoperability Fund
4 established under section 13 of this 2025 Act.

5 “(4) As used in this section:

6 “(a) ‘Public body’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.

7 “(b) ‘State government’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
8 174.111.

9 **“SECTION 13. The Statewide Interoperability Fund is established in**
10 **the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. In-**
11 **terest earned by the Statewide Interoperability Fund must be credited**
12 **to the fund. The fund consists of moneys deposited in the fund under**
13 **section 12 of this 2025 Act and may include moneys appropriated, al-**
14 **located, deposited or transferred to the fund by the Legislative As-**
15 **sembly or otherwise and interest earned on moneys in the fund. The**
16 **moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Oregon De-**
17 **partment of Emergency Management to carry out the provisions of**
18 **ORS 403.450, 403.455, 403.460 and 403.465 and section 1, chapter 825,**
19 **Oregon Laws 2005.**

20 **“SECTION 14. Notwithstanding the deadline specified in section 12**
21 **(1) of this 2025 Act, the Oregon Department of Emergency Manage-**
22 **ment shall make the estimate required under section 12 of this 2025**
23 **Act for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, on or before July 1,**
24 **2025.”.**

25 On page 6, line 1, delete “12” and insert “15”.

26 In line 7, delete “13” and insert “16”.

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
