

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5049**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “amending sections
2 3, 20, 25 and 27, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by
5 section 1, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

6 **“Sec. 3.** The following amounts are allocated for the biennium beginning
7 July 1, 2023, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund,
8 to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:

9 (1) *[Operations..... \$ 16,970,908]*

10 **Operations..... \$ 17,091,190**

11 (2) Business, innovation

12 and trade..... \$ 76,741,709

13 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 18,828,531

14 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office..... \$ 1,479,463

15 **“SECTION 2.** Section 25, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to
16 read:

17 **“Sec. 25.** (1) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the
18 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the
19 amount of \$42,884 for the purpose of grants under ORS 430.345 for the es-
20 tablishment, operation and maintenance of alcohol and drug abuse pre-
21 vention, early intervention and treatment services provided through a

1 county.

2 “(2) There is allocated to the Law Enforcement Medical Liability Account
3 established under ORS 414.815, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from
4 the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$1,300,000.

5 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon State Police for the biennium be-
6 ginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of \$351,572
7 for the purpose of enforcing the laws relating to driving under the influence
8 of intoxicants.

9 “(4) There is allocated to the Department of Corrections for the biennium
10 beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of
11 [~~\$5,197,236~~] **\$0** for the purpose of planning, operating and maintaining county
12 juvenile and adult corrections programs and facilities and drug and alcohol
13 programs. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300 (4), the grant to each county shall
14 be based on the formula used to determine the distribution of moneys under
15 the Grant-in-Aid Program under ORS 423.530.

16 “(5) There is allocated to the State Court Technology Fund established
17 under ORS 1.012, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal
18 Fine Account, the amount of [~~\$3,887,500~~] **\$2,927,500**.

19 “(6) There is allocated to the Intoxicated Driver Program Fund created
20 under ORS 813.270, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Crim-
21 inal Fine Account, the amount of \$4,323,000.

22 “(7) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium
23 beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of
24 \$331,824 for the Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Systems Program
25 created under ORS 431A.085.

26 “(8) There is allocated to the Department of Revenue for the biennium
27 beginning July 1, 2023, from the Criminal Fine Account, the amount of
28 \$100,000 for administrative costs of the department.

29 **“SECTION 3.** Section 27, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, as amended by
30 section 12, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

1 “**Sec. 27.** (1) There is allocated to the State School Fund established un-
2 der ORS 327.008, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon
3 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$40,750,659.

4 “(2) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for mental health
5 treatment or for purposes related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention, early
6 intervention and treatment services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,
7 from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of \$20,375,329.

8 “(3) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the health
9 systems division, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon
10 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$5,093,832 for purposes related to alcohol
11 and drug abuse prevention, early intervention and treatment services.

12 “(4) There is allocated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium
13 beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon Marijuana Account, the amount of
14 [~~\$190,824,043~~] **\$189,919,226**, for deposit into the Drug Treatment and Recovery
15 Services Fund.

16 “(5) There is allocated to the State Police Account established under ORS
17 181A.020, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, from the Oregon
18 Marijuana Account, the amount of \$15,281,497.

19 “**SECTION 4.** Section 20, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023, is amended to
20 read:

21 “**Sec. 20. (1)** Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning
22 July 1, 2023, the Department of Revenue shall [*distribute the moneys in*] **es-**
23 **tablish a process for distributing available moneys on a monthly basis**
24 **from** the Criminal Fine Account established by ORS 137.300 [*as specified*
25 *in*] **to fulfill the biennial distributions made by** sections 21 to 25 [*of this*
26 *2023 Act*], **chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2023.**

27 “**(2) If the moneys from the Criminal Fine Account are insufficient**
28 **to pay for the monthly distributions under subsection (1) of this sec-**
29 **tion, the department shall reduce the monthly distributions propor-**
30 **tionately in amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.**
