PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3145

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 25, after "location;" insert "or".

2 Delete line 26.

3 On page 2, delete line 1.

4 In line 2, delete "(d)" and insert "(c)".

5 In line 8, delete "group" and insert "committee".

6 Delete lines 20 through 43 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) The Housing and Community Services Department
shall enter into a contract to provide the services described in this
section.

10 **"(2) The contractor under this section shall:**

"(a) Convene a public-private advisory committee to offer input and 11 guidance on project solicitation processes and criteria as outlined in 12 section 2 (4) of this 2025 Act. The committee must include represen-13 tation from the Department of Land Conservation and Development, 14 the building codes division of the Department of Consumer and Busi-15ness Services, the Oregon Housing Stability Council and local govern-16 ments and from private firms and individuals with subject matter 17 expertise related to housing development and finance and modular and 18 manufactured housing production and installation. 19

20 "(b) Provide engagement, education, training and technical assist-21 ance needed to support the efforts of the funding recipients under section 2 of this 2025 Act within the supply chain, including assistance provided to housing developers, contractors, architects, engineers, factory operators, local governments, capital providers, transport providers, consumers and the Housing and Community Services Department.

6 "(c) Provide to funding recipients under section 2 of this 2025 Act 7 technical resources to assist with navigating regulatory frameworks, 8 innovating project delivery mechanisms, determining technical feasi-9 bility, incorporating sustainability and resiliency into design and sup-10 porting equity and inclusion within the industry.

"(d) Assist the department with its assessment of the feasibility and
 appropriateness of proposals for funding under section 2 of this 2025
 Act.

"(e) Provide systems for the transfer of knowledge necessary to set
 the industry up for success beyond the housing developed through the
 use of moneys under section 2 of this 2025 Act.

"(f) Support industry and consumer awareness by showcasing
 factory-produced housing in multiple Oregon communities and build ing a constituency for innovative housing methods and materials.

"(g) Identify sources of ongoing funding to continue the activities
 under this subsection.

"(3) The contractor shall assist the department in preparing the
 report required under section 5 of this 2025 Act.

"(4) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are
 directed to assist the contractor in the performance of the contractor's
 duties under this section.".

On page 3, line 4, after "barriers" delete the rest of the line and line 5 and insert "identified, including barriers overcome, and ability to secure additional private debt or equity;".

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
