## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2981

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$175,000 for the purpose of inspecting vessels and verifying compliance with ORS 783.625 to 783.640 to minimize the risk of introducing invasive mussels and other aquatic invasive species into the waters of this state.

9 "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-10 ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating 11 Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-12 eral Fund, the amount of \$800,000 for distribution to the Center for 13 Lakes and Reservoirs at Portland State University to monitor for 14 invasive mussels and other aquatic invasive species in Oregon's high-15 est risk waterbodies.

16 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-17 ation, there is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and 18 Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General 19 Fund, the amount of \$200,000 for the purpose of contracting to update 20 Oregon's waterbody vulnerability assessment for invasive mussels and 21 other aquatic invasive species. "SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Invasive Species Council, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000 for the purpose of facilitating interagency rapid response exercises to increase state preparedness to respond to detections of invasive mussels and other aquatic invasive species.

"SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-7 ation, there is appropriated to the Invasive Species Council, for the 8 biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount 9 of \$20,000 for the purpose of leading an interagency group in the 10 collaborative development of a framework for emergency declarations, 11 and clarification of roles and responsibilities across agencies, related 12 to the detection of invasive mussels and other aquatic invasive species. 13 "SECTION 6. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate 14 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is 15declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.". 16
