³ **"SECTION 1.** ORS 837.374 is amended to read:

"837.374. (1) Except as provided in subsection [(3)] (5) of this section, A
person commits a Class A violation if the person possesses or controls an
unmanned aircraft system and recklessly causes the unmanned aircraft system
tem to:

8 "(a) Direct a laser at an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air;

9 "(b) Crash into an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air;

10 "(c) Prevent the takeoff or landing of an aircraft; or

"(d) Interfere with a [wildfire suppression, law enforcement or emergency
 response effort] law enforcement effort or an emergency response effort
 that is not for wildfire suppression.

"(2) Except as provided in subsection [(3)] (5) of this section, a person commits a Class A misdemeanor if the person possesses or controls an unmanned aircraft system and knowingly or intentionally causes the unmanned aircraft system to:

- 18 "(a) Direct a laser at an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air;
- 19 "(b) Crash into an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air;
- 20 "(c) Prevent the takeoff or landing of an aircraft; or
- "(d) Interfere with a [wildfire suppression, law enforcement or emergency

response effort] law enforcement effort or an emergency response effort
 that is not for wildfire suppression.

"(3) Except as provided in subsections (4) and (5) of this section, a person commits a Class C felony if the person possesses or controls an unmanned aircraft system and knowingly, intentionally or recklessly causes the unmanned aircraft system to interfere with an emergency response effort for wildfire suppression.

8 "(4) A person commits a Class B felony if the person possesses or 9 controls an unmanned aircraft system and knowingly, intentionally 10 or recklessly causes property damage by causing the unmanned air-11 craft system to interfere with an emergency response effort for 12 wildfire suppression.

"[(3)] (5) A person commits a Class A felony if the person possesses or controls an unmanned aircraft system and knowingly, intentionally or recklessly causes death or serious physical injury, as defined in ORS 161.015, to another person by causing the unmanned aircraft system to:

17 "(a) Direct a laser at an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air;

18 "(b) Crash into an aircraft while the aircraft is in the air; [or]

19 "(c) Prevent the takeoff or landing of an aircraft[.]; or

20 "(d) Interfere with a law enforcement, emergency response or 21 wildfire suppression effort.

²² "[(4)] (6) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a person commits ²³ a Class A misdemeanor if the person violates subsection (1) of this section ²⁴ and the person has one or more convictions under subsection (1) of this ²⁵ section at the time of the offense.

"[(5)] (7) In addition to and not in lieu of any other sentence the court may impose, upon a person's second or subsequent conviction under this section, the court shall, at the time of sentencing, declare the unmanned aircraft system used in the offense to be contraband and order that the unmanned aircraft system be forfeited.
