**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3129**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 20, delete the second “and” and insert
2 “or”.

3 In line 22, after “to” insert “individuals who may be”.

4 On page 2, line 7, delete “and” and insert a comma and after “352.002”
5 insert “and Oregon Health and Science University”.

6 In line 8, after “of” delete the rest of the line and delete line 9 and insert
7 “providers working in the publicly funded behavioral health system.”.

8 In line 14, after “in” delete the rest of the line and insert “the publicly
9 funded behavioral health system and that include a service obligation of at
10 least two years;”.

11 In line 19, delete “for supervisors of interns” and insert “related to the
12 supervision of interns or associates”.

13 In line 29, delete “County” and insert “Community”.

14 In line 30, after “Other” insert “public” and after “employers” insert
15 “organizations”.

16 After line 42, insert:

17 **“SECTION 3. (1) Not later than June 30 of each year, each college
18 and university receiving moneys under section 2 of this 2025 Act shall
19 report annually to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission on
20 the progress and outcomes of the moneys received by the college or
21 university. The report must include:**

1 “(a) The name of any behavioral health training program funded in
2 whole or in part with the moneys received;

3 “(b) The number of students participating in behavioral health
4 training programs made available as a result of moneys received;

5 “(c) The number of students completing training that results in a
6 degree or certificate in the student’s selected field;

7 “(d) The number of students failing to complete training that re-
8 sults in a degree or certificate in the student’s selected field after the
9 student began a training program;

10 “(e) The number of students placed in careers in behavioral health,
11 and including the type of setting and location of the placement; and

12 “(f) An anonymous and aggregated list of the number of students
13 who received financial assistance under section 2 of this 2025 Act as
14 categorized by the following:

15 “(A) Age;

16 “(B) Ethnicity;

17 “(C) Gender;

18 “(D) Race;

19 “(E) Disability;

20 “(F) Language or languages spoken;

21 “(G) Sexual orientation; and

22 “(H) County of residence.

23 “SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2025 Act first applies to June 30, 2026.

24 “SECTION 5. Not later than September 1 of each year, the Higher
25 Education Coordinating Commission shall submit a report, in the
26 manner provided by ORS 192.245, setting forth the progress and out-
27 comes of the provisions of section 2 of this 2025 Act and including the
28 data described in section 3 of this 2025 Act, to the interim committees
29 of the Legislative Assembly related to behavioral health.

30 “SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2025 Act first applies to September

3 In line 45, delete “\$17,900,000” and insert “\$25,700,000”.

4 On page 3, line 3, delete “4” and insert “8”.

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
