10 **assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$17,245,820,**
11 **which may be expended for participation by the background check unit**
12 **of the department in the Rap Back program, as defined in ORS**

10 **program, as defined in ORS 181A.205.**

27 **excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
28 **Department of State Police.**

10 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
