## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 565

- Delete lines 4 through 10 of the printed bill and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) The State Parks and Recreation Department shall study:
- "(a) Options to establish a sustainable funding model to address revenue shortfalls from current state park operations.
- 6 "(b) The feasibility of operating the state parks system in a manner that 7 generates sufficient revenue to cover the expenses of operating the state 8 parks system.
- "(c) Aspects of department operations or programming that generate disproportionate funding or revenue or that may be better suited for a different organizational structure.
- "(d) Statutory or regulatory barriers to addressing the unique needs of the state parks system.
- 14 "(e) The feasibility of expanding state campgrounds in high demand areas, 15 including within 25 miles of the Oregon coast.
- "(f) The feasibility of addressing maintenance or repair needs of the aging infrastructure in the state parks system for future generations.
- "(g) Options to establish revenue sources to provide sustainable funding to meet the recreational needs of Oregonians while protecting and preserving Oregon's natural environment for future generations.".
