**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 82**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “476.696” insert “, 476.698”.

2 On page 3, delete lines 40 through 45.

3 On page 4, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 3.** ORS 476.698 is amended to read:

5 “476.698. (1) The Oregon Conservation Corps Fund is established in the  
6 State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned  
7 by the Oregon Conservation Corps Fund shall be credited to the fund.

8 “(2) The fund may receive contributions from individuals and private or-  
9 ganizations.

10 “(3) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Higher Ed-  
11 ucation Coordinating Commission to be used [*as directed by the Oregon Youth*  
12 *Works Advisory Board created under ORS 660.320*] **for purposes related to**  
13 **the Oregon Conservation Corps Program established by ORS 476.694**  
14 and for related administrative expenses of the commission.

15 “(4) The commission shall keep records of all moneys credited to and de-  
16 posited in the fund and the activity or program against which each with-  
17 drawal from the fund is charged.

18 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
19 **ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating**  
20 **Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-**  
21 **eral Fund, for deposit in the Oregon Conservation Corps Fund estab-**

lished by ORS 476.698:

“(1) The amount of \$10,000,000, for the purpose of funding grant-supported projects related to the Oregon Conservation Corps Program established by ORS 476.694.

“(2) The amount of \$5,000,000, to match dollar-for-dollar funds secured from sources other than state government that are dedicated for the purpose of funding grant-supported projects related to the Oregon Conservation Corps Program.”.

In line 3, delete “4” and insert “5”.
