**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2680**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 8 through 10 and insert:

2 “(a)(A) ‘Fenestration product or system’ means a window, glass, glazing
3 or glazing system or skylight, whether installed in a horizontal or vertical
4 plane, that is designed to provide a weatherproof barrier.

5 “(B) ‘Fenestration product or system’ does not include a premanufactured
6 window or skylight.”.

7 On page 2, delete lines 21 through 45 and delete page 3.

8 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 11 and insert:

9 **“SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this 2025 Act is amended to read:

10 **“Sec. 2.** (1) As used in this section:

11 “(a)(A) ‘Fenestration product or system’ means a window, glass, glazing
12 or glazing system or skylight, whether installed in a horizontal or vertical
13 plane, that is designed to provide a weatherproof barrier.

14 “(B) ‘Fenestration product or system’ does not include a premanufactured
15 window or skylight.

16 “(b) ‘National certification’ means a certification that meets one of the
17 following standards:

18 “(A) For glazing contractors, a certification that is in effect on the ef-
19 fective date of this 2025 Act and that Administrative Management Systems,
20 Incorporated, or a successor organization, administers under the North
21 American Contractor Certification program; or

1 “(B) For architectural glass and metal technicians, the Architectural
2 Glass and Metal Technician national certification, as in effect on the effec-
3 tive date of this 2025 Act, that Administrative Management Systems, Incor-
4 porated, or a successor organization, administers.

5 “(c) ‘Public agency’ means the State of Oregon or a political subdivision
6 of the State of Oregon or a county, city, district, authority, public corpo-
7 ration or public entity that is organized and exists under a law or charter
8 or an instrumentality of the county, city, district, authority, public corpo-
9 ration or public entity.

10 “(d) ‘Public funds’ means funds of which an officer or employee of a public
11 body, as defined in ORS 174.109, has custody or control by virtue of a legal
12 right that the public body confers by law upon the officer or employee to
13 direct the collection, use or transfer of moneys payable to, belonging to or
14 collected for the public body.

15 “(2) A public agency that provides public funds to install, repair or re-
16 model a fenestration product or system in a public building that the public
17 agency constructs, remodels or repairs and owns or leases shall require, as
18 a condition of providing the public funds for the installation, repair or re-
19 modeling, that:

20 “(a) The contractor that installs, repairs or remodels the fenestration
21 product or system:

22 “(A) Has all licenses and insurance required to perform construction work
23 in this state; and

24 “(B) Has a national certification as a glazing contractor; and

25 “(b) One or more of the workers or technicians that provides the labor
26 for, or direct oversight of, the installation, repair or remodeling has a na-
27 tional certification as an architectural glass and metal technician.

28 “(3) The requirement set forth in subsection (2) of this section applies to
29 public buildings in which a public agency provides of \$5 million or more in
30 public funds for new construction or \$1 million or more in public funds for

1 the installation, repair or remodeling of a fenestration product or system in
2 a public building that the public agency constructs, remodels or repairs and
3 owns or leases.

4 “(4) A contractor that installs, repairs or remodels a fenestration product
5 or system in a public building described in subsection (3) of this section, in
6 addition to having a national certification as a glazing contractor, must
7 *[employ at least one worker or technician with a national certification as an*
8 *architectural glass and metal technician]* **demonstrate to the public agency**
9 **as a condition of receiving public funds that at least 25 percent of the**
10 **contractor’s employees who install, repair or remodel fenestration**
11 **products or systems have a national certification as architectural glass**
12 **and metal technicians.**

13 **“SECTION 4.** Section 2 of this 2025 Act, as amended by section 3 of this
14 2025 Act, is amended to read:

15 **“Sec. 2.** (1) As used in this section:

16 “(a)(A) ‘Fenestration product or system’ means a window, glass, glazing
17 or glazing system or skylight, whether installed in a horizontal or vertical
18 plane, that is designed to provide a weatherproof barrier.

19 “(B) ‘Fenestration product or system’ does not include a premanufactured
20 window or skylight.

21 “(b) ‘National certification’ means a certification that meets one of the
22 following standards:

23 “(A) For glazing contractors, a certification that is in effect on the ef-
24 fective date of this 2025 Act and that Administrative Management Systems,
25 Incorporated, or a successor organization, administers under the North
26 American Contractor Certification program; or

27 “(B) For architectural glass and metal technicians, the Architectural
28 Glass and Metal Technician national certification, as in effect on the effec-
29 tive date of this 2025 Act, that Administrative Management Systems, Incor-

30 “(4) A contractor that installs, repairs or remodels a fenestration product

1 or system in a public building described in subsection (3) of this section, in
2 addition to having a national certification as a glazing contractor, must
3 demonstrate to the public agency as a condition of receiving public funds
4 that at least [25] **50** percent of the contractor's employees who install, repair
5 or remodel fenestration products or systems have a national certification as
6 architectural glass and metal technicians.”.
