- "SECTION 1. The Housing and Community Services Department shall contract with the Housing Development Center, Inc., for the purposes of:
- "(1) Improving occupancy rates, expediting move-ins, preventing evictions, reducing residential turnover and enhancing the wellbeing of residents in affordable housing projects by:
- "(a) Developing and delivering resources for training and capacitybuilding to improve property management operations and practices at affordable housing projects; and
  - "(b) Making grants to nonprofit corporations, federally recognized Indian tribes in this state, local governments and housing authorities, in order to support property management staffing and operations at specific affordable housing projects that the recipient owns or operates or where the recipient provides property management services.
- 18 **"(2) Advancing the growth and availability of culturally responsive** 19 **property management services.**
- 20 "(3) Providing asset management training to nonprofit corpo-21 rations, federally recognized Indian tribes in this state, local govern-

- ments and housing authorities that own or operate affordable housing projects.
- "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on June 30, 2027.
- 4 "SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 5 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
- 6 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-
- 7 eral Fund, the following amounts:
- 8 "(1) \$3,000,000 to contract for services under section 1 (1) of this 2025

- "(2) \$3,000,000 to contract for services under section 1 (2) of this 2025
- 11 **Act.**
- "(3) \$1,300,000 to contract for services under section 1 (3) of this 2025

- "SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
- preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
- declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.".
