**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3727**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 30 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 “(4)(a) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, a physician licensed
4 under ORS 677.100 to 677.228 or physician associate licensed under ORS
5 677.505 to 677.525 may use telemedicine to engage in the practice of medicine
6 and provide health care services to a patient who is temporarily located out
7 of state if:

8 “(A) The practice of medicine or provision of health care services is of a
9 temporary, urgent or emergent nature or is to ensure continuity of care to
10 the patient; and

11 “(B) The physician or physician associate has an established patient-
12 provider relationship with the patient prior to the time at which the patient
13 is located out of state.

14 “(b) A physician or physician associate who uses telemedicine as provided
15 under this subsection is subject to the laws regulating the practice of medi-
16 cine in the jurisdiction where the patient is located at the time the patient
17 receives health care services provided under this subsection.”.

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
