Whereas community mental health programs are required by statute to provide specific services to individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis, individuals charged with a crime and found unable to aid and assist in their own defense and individuals subject to civil commitment proceedings; and

Whereas the Oregon Health Authority conducted, pursuant to section 1, chapter 80, Oregon Laws 2024, a cost study to determine the funding required for each community mental health program to provide those services; and

¹⁵ "Whereas the cost study, which was completed with the assistance of an ¹⁶ actuary, determined that there is a gap between the funding that is currently ¹⁷ available and the funding that is needed for community mental health pro-¹⁸ grams to provide the services required by statute; now, therefore,".

²⁰ "<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-²¹ ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount 1 of \$64,800,000, for distribution to community mental health programs $\mathbf{2}$ for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 161.315 to 161.351, 3 161.355 to 161.371, 161.385 to 161.395, 161.505 to 161.585, 426.005 to 426.390, 4 426.510 to 426.680, 426.701, 426.702, 430.627, 430.628, 430.629 and 430.630. $\mathbf{5}$ "SECTION 2.
