## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 28

1 Delete lines 5 through 17 of the printed joint resolution and insert:

<sup>2</sup> "SECTION 48. (1) All people, including children and future gener-<sup>3</sup> ations, have the inherent fundamental right to a clean, safe and <sup>4</sup> healthy environment, including but not limited to clean air, clean <sup>5</sup> water, thriving ecosystems and a stable climate system. This right <sup>6</sup> shall not be abridged unless justified by a compelling state interest <sup>7</sup> achieved by the means least restrictive of the right.

8 "(2) All of Oregon's public natural resources are the common 9 property of all the people, including generations yet to come. As 10 trustee of these resources with affirmative fiduciary obligations, the 11 state shall conserve and maintain public natural resources against 12 substantial impairment for the benefit of all people.

"(3) Any person may obtain declaratory or equitable relief to en-13 force the rights and duties guaranteed under this section against state 14 action or inaction allowing harm, or the threat of harm, to public 15safety or health. Prevailing parties securing protection of rights or 16 enforcement of duties under this section shall be entitled to costs of 17 litigation, including reasonable attorney and expert witness fees. The 18 rights and duties guaranteed under this section are self-executing and 19 enforceable upon enactment, without implementing legislation or ex-20 haustion of other remedies.". 21
