PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2529

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 29.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 and insert:

³ **"SECTION 1.** ORS 339.345 is amended to read:

"339.345. [Each school campus in a school district, private school campus
and public charter school campus shall have on the premises at least one automated external defibrillator.]

7 "(1) As used in this section:

"(a) 'Athletic venue' means any location in a building or on the
grounds of any kindergarten through grade 12 public or private school
where athletic practices or competitions are held for school-sponsored
events or for which students are in attendance.

12 "(b) 'Coach' has the meaning given that term in ORS 336.485.

"(c) 'School' means the buildings and grounds of any kindergarten
 through grade 12 public or private school, excluding athletic venues.

15 "(2) The governing body for a school shall ensure that:

16 "(a) Automated external defibrillators are located:

17 "(A) At each school at locations that are selected, to the greatest 18 extent practicable, in accordance with guidelines established by a na-19 tional organization focused on emergency cardiovascular care; and

20 **"(B) At each athletic venue.**

21 "(b) The automated external defibrillator location is clearly identi-

1 fied and is unlocked and accessible:

"(A) For automated external defibrillators located in a school, when
 students are at the school; and

4 "(B) For automated external defibrillators located at an athletic
5 venue, when students are at the athletic venue for athletic practices
6 or competitions.

7 "(c) Automated external defibrillators are tested and maintained as
8 provided by the manufacturer's guidelines.

9 "(d) Every coach is trained in the use of automated external 10 defibrillators.

"(e) The ratio of the number of students to the number of staff members who are trained in the use of automated external defibrillators is the same as the ratio prescribed for staff members who hold a first aid card under ORS 342.664.

"(3) Training required under subsection (2) of this section must
 align with guidelines established by a national organization focused
 on emergency cardiovascular care and may be provided as part of first
 aid training required under ORS 342.664.

"(4) Any school plan for responding to medical emergencies must
 include:

"(a) A plan for cardiac emergency responses, including the use of
automated external defibrillators, that aligns with core elements established by a national organization focused on emergency
cardiovascular care; and

"(b) Identification of the locations of automated external
defibrillators, which must be shared with emergency medical services
providers.".

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
