**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3010**

1 Delete lines 5 through 25 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon State University Extension Service, in**
3 **cooperation with the State Department of Agriculture, shall develop**
4 **and implement a statewide program of culturally appropriate Spanish**
5 **language pesticide education for farmworkers, pesticide consultants,**
6 **operators, applicators, noncommercial applicators, private applicators**
7 **and trainees. The program shall be implemented as a part of the pro-**
8 **gram operated by the extension service to provide pesticide safety ed-**
9 **ucation.**

10 **“(2) Educational materials and instruction provided under the pro-**
11 **gram must be consistent with the programs of instruction and courses**
12 **of study established under ORS 634.306 (8).**

13 **“(3) Instruction provided in Spanish must include, but need not be**
14 **limited to, training regarding:**

15 **“(a) Worker protection standards established by the federal Envi-**
16 **ronmental Protection Agency;**

17 **“(b) Best practices to protect water quality; and**

18 **“(c) Other practices for the safe handling of pesticides to protect**
19 **worker health and the environment.**

20 **“(4) Educational materials provided in Spanish must include, but**
21 **need not be limited to:**

1 “(a) Training materials;

2 “(b) Study guides; and

3 “(c) Web-based content.

4 “SECTION 3. (1) No later than December 31, 2025, Oregon State
5 University, in cooperation with the State Department of Agriculture,
6 shall complete the development of the Spanish language version of the
7 online precertification training program offered by the Oregon State
8 University Pesticide Safety Education Program.

9 “(2)(a) Upon completion of the Spanish language version of the on-
10 line precertification training program, the university, in cooperation
11 with the department, shall, through Oregon State University Exten-
12 sion Service offices located throughout the state, publicize the avail-
13 ability of the program and provide information about the program to
14 any interested person.

15 “(b) The department shall provide information about the program
16 to any interested person in the course of the department’s regular
17 outreach efforts throughout the state.

18 “SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,
19 2028.

20 “SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
21 ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating
22 Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-
23 eral Fund, the amount of \$40,000, for distribution to Oregon State
24 University to carry out section 3 of this 2025 Act.

25 “SECTION 6. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
26 ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating
27 Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the Gen-
28 eral Fund, the amount of \$744,124, for distribution to the Oregon State
29 University Extension Service Pesticide Safety Education Program to
30 carry out section 2 of this 2025 Act.”.

1 In line 26, delete “4” and insert “7”.

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
