**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3326**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “seniors” insert “; and prescribing an
2 effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Coordinated care organization’ has the meaning given that
6 term in ORS 414.025.**

7 **“(b) ‘Dental care organization’ means a prepaid managed care
8 health services organization, as defined in ORS 414.025, that provides
9 dental care to members of a coordinated care organization.**

10 **“(c) ‘Medical assistance’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
11 414.025.**

12 **“(2) The Seniors Emergency Dental Program is established in the
13 Oregon Health Authority to provide emergency dental services to eli-
14 gible seniors.**

15 **“(3) The authority shall contract with dental care organizations
16 throughout this state and with individual health care providers in
17 areas of this state that are not served by dental care organizations to
18 provide the following emergency dental services to eligible seniors
19 without any corresponding copayments, deductibles or cost sharing
20 required:**

21 **“(a) Emergency extractions;**

1 “(b) Limited oral evaluation; and

2 “(c) Necessary X-ray services, including periapical, bitewing, pano-
3 ramic and cone beam.

4 “(4) An individual is eligible for the Seniors Emergency Dental
5 Program if the individual:

6 “(a) Is at least 65 years of age;

7 “(b) Is ineligible for medical assistance; and

8 “(c) Has income that is at or below 400 percent of the federal pov-
9 erty guidelines.

10 “(5) The authority may adopt any rules necessary to carry out the
11 provisions of this section.

12 “SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act becomes operative on
13 January 1, 2026.

14 “(2) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the
15 operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is neces-
16 sary to enable the authority to exercise, on and after the operative
17 date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, func-
18 tions and powers conferred on the authority by section 1 of this 2025
19 Act.

20 “SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
21 date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative
22 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.
