**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3211**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 13 through 20 and insert:

2 “(g) ‘Skilled nursing facility’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
3 442.015.

4 “(2)(a) The Oregon Health Authority shall develop by rule a nonopioid
5 directive form indicating to health care providers and emergency medical
6 services providers that, except as otherwise provided in subsection (4) of this
7 section or by rule, an individual who has executed the nonopioid directive
8 form or who has had a nonopioid directive form executed on the individual’s
9 behalf may not be administered an opioid or offered a prescription for an
10 opioid.

11 “(b) The authority shall include on the nonopioid directive form:

12 “(A) A warning that execution of the nonopioid directive form may result
13 in the individual having unrelieved or breakthrough pain that would other-
14 wise be adequately managed with the use of an opioid;

15 “(B) Instructions on how the form may be revoked; and

16 “(C) Any other information that the authority considers relevant.

17 “(c) The authority shall make the form available to the public electron-
18 ically on the authority’s website.

19 “(d) An individual may not be required to execute a nonopioid directive
20 form as a condition for receiving health care services.

21 “(e) Upon being presented with a nonopioid directive form, a physician

1 or other health care provider shall make the form a part of the individual's
2 medical record.”.

3 On page 2, line 15, delete “or”.

4 In line 16, delete the period and insert “; or

5 “(c) The individual is being treated at a skilled nursing facility.”.

6 In line 17, delete “Except as otherwise provided by law,”.

7 In line 21, delete “reasonably and”.

8 In line 28, delete “Subject to subsection (7) of this section,”.

9 Delete lines 42 to 44.

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
