**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3941**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 **“(a) ‘Labor organization’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
5 **243.650.**

6 **“(b) ‘Services traditionally and customarily performed by employees**
7 **of a school district or an education service district’ includes instruc-**
8 **tion, instructional support, counseling, behavioral and mental health**
9 **services, family engagement and student supervision.**

10 **“(2) The Department of Education shall establish and administer a**
11 **grant program for full-service community schools. For the purpose of**
12 **the program, the department may enter into a contract with a**
13 **nonprofit entity that has experience with full-service community**
14 **schools.**

15 **“(3) An eligible school district or an eligible education service dis-**
16 **trict may apply to participate in the grant program under this section.**
17 **A school district or an education service district is eligible to apply for**
18 **a grant if the school district or education service district:**

19 **“(a) Is part of a consortium for the purpose of the grant that con-**
20 **sists of:**

21 **“(A) One or more school districts;**

1 **“(B) One or more community-based organizations;**

2 **“(C) A labor organization; and**

3 **“(D) Any combination of education service districts, federally re-**
4 **cognized tribes, nonprofit organizations and other public and private**
5 **entities.**

6 **“(b) Is able to provide matching funds in accordance with rules**
7 **adopted by the State Board of Education.**

8 **“(c) Has a plan for engaging with the community to create and**
9 **maintain a full-service community school, as described in subsection**
10 **(4) of this section.**

11 **“(4)(a) A consortium that receives moneys under this section must**
12 **use the moneys to create and maintain a full-service community**
13 **school. A full-service community school is a public school that meets**
14 **the requirements prescribed by the State Board of Education by rule,**
15 **including the provision of:**

16 **“(A) A community-based effort to coordinate and integrate educa-**
17 **tional, developmental, family, health and other comprehensive ser-**
18 **vices through community-based organizations and public and private**
19 **partnerships; and**

20 **“(B) Access to the services described in paragraph (a) of this sub-**
21 **section at a school:**

22 **“(i) To students, families and the community; and**

23 **“(ii) At times that may include during and after school hours, on**
24 **weekends and during summer.**

25 **“(b) A consortium that receives moneys under this section must**
26 **ensure that services traditionally and customarily performed by em-**
27 **ployees of a school district or an education service district and that**
28 **are funded by the moneys received under this section may not be**
29 **provided by private entities unless:**

30 **“(A) Individuals who are employed by the school district or the ed-**

1 **ucation service district are given the first opportunity to provide ser-**
2 **vices funded by the moneys received under this section;**

3 **“(B) No qualified individual employed by the school district or the**
4 **education service district is willing or available to provide the services;**
5 **and**

6 **“(C) The individuals providing the services through the private en-**
7 **tity are represented by a labor organization.**

8 **“(5)(a) For the purpose of administering the grant program, the**
9 **department or the entity under contract with the department shall**
10 **establish a committee with members who have experience in trauma-**
11 **informed school systems, culturally specific community engagement,**
12 **school health services, health or education equity practices, labor or-**
13 **ganizations, school or community needs assessments, after-school**
14 **programs or full-service community schools.**

15 **“(b) The committee established under this subsection shall:**

16 **“(A) Make recommendations for rules to the State Board of Edu-**
17 **cation; and**

18 **“(B) Assist the department or the entity under contract with the**
19 **department in providing quality implementation of the grant program.**

20 **“(c) A member of the committee is entitled to compensation in the**
21 **manner and amounts provided in ORS 292.495. Claims for compen-**
22 **sation and expenses incurred in performing the functions of the com-**
23 **mittee shall be paid by the department or the entity under contract**
24 **with the department.**

25 **“(6) The department, or the entity under contract with the depart-**
26 **ment, shall select eligible applicants to receive a grant. The selection**
27 **of the applicants and the terms of the grant agreement shall take into**
28 **consideration the recommendations of the committee established un-**
29 **der subsection (5) of this section.**

30 **“(7) No later than September 15 of each even-numbered year, the**

1 department shall submit a report concerning the grant program to the
2 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education.

3 “(8) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary for
4 the implementation of this section. When adopting rules, the board
5 shall consult with the committee established under subsection (5) of
6 this section.

7 “SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,
8 2025, from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund,
9 to the Department of Education, the amount of \$4,990,000 for the grant
10 program established and administered as provided by section 1 of this
11 2025 Act.

12 “SECTION 3. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
13 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
14 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.”.

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
