**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2688**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 44 and 45.

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:

3 “(G) Bespoke, off-site fabrication, preconstruction, assembly or con-
4 struction work performed specifically for, and in accordance with the spec-
5 ifications of, a particular project of a type listed in subparagraphs (A) to (F)
6 of this paragraph, for the following systems:

7 “(i) Mechanical systems such as heating, ventilation, air conditioning,
8 refrigeration and other ducting or piping systems or components;

9 “(ii) Plumbing systems or components;

10 “(iii) Electrical systems or components of electrical systems that conform
11 with the requirements of ORS 479.510 to 479.945 and the rules of the Elec-
12 trical and Elevator Board;

13 “(iv) Boiler systems or components of boiler systems;

14 “(v) Ornamental and structural iron work;

15 “(vi) Masonry and plaster systems or components;

16 “(vii) Roofing, flashing and architectural panel systems or components
17 other than glazing systems and components; and

18 “(viii) Mechanical insulation work.”.

19 In line 27, delete “January” and insert “July”.

20 Delete lines 28 through 35 and insert:

21 “(2)(a) The Attorney General, the Director of the Oregon Department of

1 Administrative Services, the Director of Transportation and a contracting
2 agency that adopts rules under ORS 279A.065 or 279A.070 may adopt rules
3 and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection
4 (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the Attorney General, the di-
5 rectors or the contracting agency to undertake and exercise all of the duties,
6 functions and powers conferred on the Attorney General, the directors or the
7 contracting agency by the amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1 of this
8 2025 Act.

9 “(b) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall adopt
10 rules that, among other items, specify which manufacturing and which
11 standard inventory items are excluded from the definition of public works
12 and the requirements for reporting off-site work, and may take any other
13 action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section
14 that is necessary to enable the commissioner to undertake and exercise all
15 of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the commissioner by the
16 amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1 of this 2025 Act.”.
