**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1191**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 20 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 162.235 is amended to read:

3 “162.235. (1) A person commits the crime of obstructing governmental or
4 judicial administration if the person:

5 “(a) Intentionally obstructs, impairs or hinders the administration of law
6 or other governmental or judicial function by means of intimidation, force,
7 physical or economic interference or obstacle;

8 “(b) With intent to defraud, engages in the business of or acts in the ca-
9 pacity of a notary public as defined in ORS 194.215 without having received
10 a commission as a notary public from the Secretary of State; or

11 “(c) With intent to defraud, engages in the business of or acts in the ca-
12 pacity of an immigration consultant, as defined in ORS 9.280, in violation
13 of ORS 9.160.

14 “(2)(a) This section [*shall*] **does** not apply to the obstruction of unlawful
15 governmental or judicial action or interference with the making of an arrest.

16 **“(b) Subsection (1)(a) of this section does not apply to the act of**
17 **informing another person of the other person’s civil or constitutional**
18 **rights.**

19 “(3) Obstructing governmental or judicial administration is a Class A
20 misdemeanor.”.

21 In line 25, after “act” insert “, by itself,”.
