**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2940**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Subject to the availability of funds, the Oregon Health
4 Authority shall implement a program for providing to emergency de-
5 partments in real time notifications that:**

6 **“(1) Identify patients with hemoglobinopathies; and**

7 **“(2) Provide information on how to contact a hematologist in real
8 time.**

9 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall consult with
10 interested stakeholders to inform the authority in implementing the
11 program described under section 1 of this 2025 Act. Interested
12 stakeholders must include, at a minimum, the following persons:**

13 **“(a) A person from the authority’s Office of Health Information
14 Technology and Analytics Infrastructure.**

15 **“(b) A person with relevant experience who represents a hospital.**

16 **“(c) A person who represents a community organization that serves
17 patients with sickle cell disease or other hemoglobinopathies.**

18 **“(d) A person who represents public health organizations.**

19 **“(e) Health care providers with relevant experience, including but
20 not limited to:**

21 **“(A) Hematologists.**

1 **“(B) Hematology nurses.**

2 **“(C) Emergency physicians.**

3 **“(D) Emergency nurses.**

4 **“(E) Emergency room nurses.**

5 **“(F) Emergency medical technicians.**

6 **“(G) Paramedics.**

7 **“(2) A member of the Legislative Assembly or a staff member for**
8 **a member of the Legislative Assembly may participate in the**
9 **authority’s efforts to consult with interested stakeholders.**

10 **“(3) The authority shall submit a report on the information gath-**
11 **ered from interested stakeholders under this section and the status**
12 **of the program described under section 1 of this 2025 Act in the man-**
13 **ner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for**
14 **legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**
15 **lated to health care no later than March 1, 2026.**

16 **“SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,**
17 **2027.**

18 **“SECTION 4. Subject to the availability of funds, the Oregon Health**
19 **Authority shall implement the program described under section 1 of**
20 **this 2025 Act no later than May 1, 2026.**

21 **“SECTION 5. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
22 **date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative**
23 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
