**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3731**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “education;” delete the rest of  
2 the line and delete line 3 and insert “amending ORS 350.345.”.

3 In line 13, after “include” insert “the following”.

4 Delete lines 14 through 16 and insert:

5 “(a) The total number of allegations of sexual misconduct that were re-  
6 ported during the previous academic year to the institution’s Title IX coor-  
7 dinator by a student or employee of the institution against:

8 “(A) Another student or employee of the institution;

9 “(B) An individual who is known by the institution not to be a student  
10 or employee of the institution; or

11 “(C) An individual who is unknown to the institution.”.

12 In line 19, after “against” delete the rest of the line and insert “:

13 “(A) Another student or employee of the institution;

14 “(B) An individual who is known by the institution not to be a student  
15 or employee of the institution; or

16 “(C) An individual who is unknown to the institution.”.

17 In line 21, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

18 In line 24, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

19 In line 27, delete the semicolon and insert “. If the number under this  
20 paragraph exceeds eight, the report must include a reason for each investi-  
21 gation being closed, including:

1 “(A) The investigation was referred to a different department at the in-  
2 stitution;

3 “(B) The complainant was only seeking support by filing the complaint;

4 “(C) The parties used an informal resolution process to resolve a com-  
5 plaint;

6 “(D) The complainant withdrew the complaint;

7 “(E) The institution dismissed the complaint;

8 “(F) The complaint was referred to a different department at the institu-  
9 tion;

10 “(G) Final adjudication, including any applicable appeal, was reached  
11 under the grievance procedures of the institution;

12 “(H) Circumstances prevented the institution from gathering evidence  
13 sufficient to reach a determination regarding the complaint or any allegation  
14 in the complaint;

15 “(I) The complainant did not respond to outreach by the institution;

16 “(J) The complainant was anonymous; or

17 “(K) Another reason identified by the institution.”.

18 In line 29, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

19 On page 2, line 4, delete the semicolon and insert “. The number under  
20 this paragraph must be accompanied by a list of supportive measures, in-  
21 cluding emergency housing, if available, offered by the institution and the  
22 number of times each supportive measure was used.”.

23 In line 5, after “who” insert “, after experiencing alleged sexual miscon-  
24 duct,”.

25 In line 7, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

26 In line 9, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

27 In line 10, delete the semicolon and insert a period.

28 Delete lines 11 through 24 and insert:

29 “(L) The types of violence reported at the institution. For any institution  
30 with fewer than eight reports under this paragraph, the institution shall

1 provide the number of reports for each of the following:

2 “(A) Dating violence;

3 “(B) Domestic violence;

4 “(C) Sexual harassment;

5 “(D) Retaliation;

6 “(E) Sexual assault, including rape, physical touching of a sexual nature,  
7 statutory rape and incest;

8 “(F) Sexual exploitation; and

9 “(G) Stalking.

10 “(m) A narrative section in which the institution may:

11 “(A) Describe any work being done at the institution to ensure the insti-  
12 tution has accurate information;

13 “(B) Explain any trends and changes in data regarding the numbers being  
14 reported;

15 “(C) Discuss any supportive measures provided or potential gaps in sup-  
16 portive measures being provided; and

17 “(D) Discuss how the institution is working to eliminate sexual miscon-  
18 duct on the campus of the institution.”.

19 Delete lines 30 through 32 and insert:

20 “(5) Notwithstanding the page limit described in ORS 192.245 (1), the  
21 executive summary for a report submitted under this section must be not  
22 more than four pages.

23 **“SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 350.345 by section 1 of this**  
24 **2025 Act first apply to reports submitted for the 2025-2026 academic**  
25 **year.”.**

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
