## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1019

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete "and".

2 In line 5, before the period insert "; and declaring an emergency".

3 On page 11, after line 31, insert:

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## **"MODERNIZATION TASK FORCE**

"SECTION 18. The Legislative Policy and Research Director shall
conduct a comparative analysis of how other states administer brand
inspection programs. The director shall submit a report to the Task
Force on Modernizing Oregon's Brand Inspection Program established
under section 19 of this 2025 Act no later than October 30, 2025.

"SECTION 19. (1) The Task Force on Modernizing Oregon's Brand
 Inspection Program is established.

14 "(2) The task force consists of 11 members appointed as follows:

"(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from
 among members of the Senate.

"(b) The Senate Republican Leader shall appoint one member from
 among members of the Senate.

"(c) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one
 member from among members of the House of Representatives.

21 "(d) The House Republican Leader shall appoint one member from

1 among members of the House of Representatives.

"(e)(A) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House
of Representatives shall jointly appoint members as follows:

4 "(i) Two representatives of livestock organizations;

5 "(ii) Two livestock operations owners; and

6 "(iii) Two dairy farm operations owners.

"(B) The Director of Agriculture, or the director's designee, shall
serve as a nonvoting ex officio member of the task force.

9 "(C) Appointing authorities shall ensure, to the extent practicable, 10 that members appointed under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph 11 equally represent the various geographic regions of this state, includ-12 ing eastern, Willamette Valley, coastal and southern localities.

13 **"(3) The task force shall:** 

14 "(a) Identify challenges related to brand inspection, enforcement
 15 and program administration;

"(b) Assess the comparative analysis submitted under section 18 of
 this 2025 Act; and

"(c) Consider potential policy changes to modernize the program
 while maintaining the program's effectiveness.

"(4) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
Representatives shall select one member of the task force to serve as
chairperson and another to serve as vice chairperson.

"(5) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority
 shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.

"(6) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the
call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the
task force.

"(7) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of
 the task force.

30 "(8) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided

by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to
 an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to agricul ture and natural resources no later than September 15, 2026.

4 "(9) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task
5 force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an ad6 visory capacity only.

"(10) Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement
for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.

10 "(11) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, 11 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the duties 12 of the task force and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to 13 confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the 14 task force consider necessary to perform their duties.

"SECTION 20. Section 19 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,
 2027.".

## **"EMERGENCY CLAUSE**

"<u>SECTION 22.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.".

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
