**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3323**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “prescribing an effective
2 date” and insert “declaring an emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2025 Act are added to and
5 made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) When a police officer issues a citation for a traffic
7 violation to a person under 18 years of age whose driving record shows
8 no prior convictions for traffic offenses, the officer shall notify the
9 person that a driver improvement course is available and that if the
10 person successfully completes a driver improvement course, approved
11 by the Department of Transportation under section 3 of this 2025 Act,
12 at the person’s own expense, the person will not be convicted of the
13 violation. Notification consists of giving the person a form developed
14 by the department, along with the citation and summons. This sub-
15 section does not apply to a person who has already taken a driver
16 improvement course.**

17 **“(2) The department shall develop a form to be given to a person
18 described in subsection (1) of this section who is issued a citation. The
19 form:**

20 **“(a) Must explain that completion of the course will enable the
21 person to avoid a conviction;**

1 **“(b) Must explain that taking the course is available only to indi-**
2 **viduals who have not already taken the course under this section; and**

3 **“(c) Must explain how the person may obtain information about a**
4 **course.**

5 **“(3) When a person has successfully completed a course described**
6 **in this section, the instructor shall issue a certificate to the person**
7 **indicating completion. When the person presents the certificate of**
8 **completion to the court, the court shall dismiss the citation.**

9 **“(4) The department may adopt rules it deems necessary for the**
10 **implementation of this section.**

11 **“(5) Nothing in this section is intended to impact diversion pro-**
12 **grams, which may be offered by a local court, as defined in ORS**
13 **137.145, or a circuit court.**

14 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Transportation by rule shall**
15 **establish standards for a driver improvement course provided to per-**
16 **sons pursuant to section 2 of this 2025 Act. The standards must de-**
17 **scribe the contents and quality of a curriculum for the course, specify**
18 **requirements for obtaining a certificate and otherwise determine the**
19 **level and depth of knowledge a person must have obtained from the**
20 **course.**

21 **“(2) The department shall maintain a list of providers approved to**
22 **lead the course described in this section and shall update the list**
23 **monthly. The department shall prescribe procedures for providing the**
24 **provider list to police officers.**

25 **“SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies to persons issued**
26 **citations for traffic violations on or after January 1, 2026.**

27 **“SECTION 5. (1) Sections 2 and 3 of this 2025 Act become operative**
28 **on January 1, 2026.**

29 **“(2) The Department of Transportation may adopt rules and take**
30 **any other action before the operative date specified in subsection (1)**

1 of this section that is necessary to enable the department to exercise,
2 on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this sec-
3 tion, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department
4 by sections 2 and 3 of this 2025 Act.

5 **“SECTION 6. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate**
6 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
7 **declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
