## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3532

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 25 and insert:

2 **"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:** 

"(a) 'Interested party' means an individual or entity with a right
to property that may be affected by a change of name pursuant to this
section.

"(b) 'Offensive' means insulting and derogatory to any of Oregon's
nine federally recognized Indian tribes or to any race, nationality or
ethnicity.

9 "(2) The Oregon Historical Society shall:

"(a) Compile a list of highways as defined in ORS 801.305 and ge ographic features including, but not limited to, mountains, buttes,
 gulleys, gulches, rivers and creeks in Oregon that bear offensive
 names; and

"(b) Begin a process of determining new names for the highways
 and geographic features.

"(3)(a) In fulfilling its duties under subsection (2) of this section,
 the society shall consult with:

18 "(A) The Oregon Geographic Names Board;

19 "(B) Oregon's nine federally recognized Indian tribes;

20 "(C) County and municipal leaders;

21 **"(D) Representatives of state government;** 

- 1 "(E) Local landowners; and
- 2 "(F) Interested parties.

"(b) Leaders and representatives shall be consulted only with respect to highways and geographic features within the jurisdictions
they represent.

6 "(4) The society shall submit proposals to the U.S. Board on Ge-7 ographic Names recommending names that are not offensive for all 8 highways and geographic features on the list compiled under sub-9 section (2)(a) of this section no later than the date that is three years 10 following the effective date of this 2025 Act.".
