**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3532**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 25 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

3 **“(a) ‘Interested party’ means an individual or entity with a right**
4 **to property that may be affected by a change of name pursuant to this**
5 **section.**

6 **“(b) ‘Offensive’ means insulting and derogatory to any of Oregon’s**
7 **nine federally recognized Indian tribes or to any race, nationality or**
8 **ethnicity.**

9 **“(2) The Oregon Historical Society shall:**

10 **“(a) Compile a list of highways as defined in ORS 801.305 and ge-**
11 **ographic features including, but not limited to, mountains, buttes,**
12 **gulleys, gulches, rivers and creeks in Oregon that bear offensive**
13 **names; and**

14 **“(b) Begin a process of determining new names for the highways**
15 **and geographic features.**

16 **“(3)(a) In fulfilling its duties under subsection (2) of this section,**
17 **the society shall consult with:**

18 **“(A) The Oregon Geographic Names Board;**

19 **“(B) Oregon’s nine federally recognized Indian tribes;**

20 **“(C) County and municipal leaders;**

21 **“(D) Representatives of state government;**

1 **“(E) Local landowners; and**

2 **“(F) Interested parties.**

3 **“(b) Leaders and representatives shall be consulted only with re-**
4 **spect to highways and geographic features within the jurisdictions**
5 **they represent.**

6 **“(4) The society shall submit proposals to the U.S. Board on Ge-**
7 **ographic Names recommending names that are not offensive for all**
8 **highways and geographic features on the list compiled under sub-**
9 **section (2)(a) of this section no later than the date that is three years**
10 **following the effective date of this 2025 Act.”.**
