PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3825

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the second semicolon delete the rest of the line and delete line 3 and insert "amending ORS 137.225; and prescribing an effective date.".
- 4 Delete lines 5 through 27.
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 18.194, judgment remedies for a judgment of conviction in a municipal court or justice court for violating a city or county ordinance or state statute prohibiting the possession of less than one ounce of marijuana, that have not yet expired under the provisions of ORS 18.194, expire on the effective date of this 2025 Act."
- On page 3, delete lines 4 through 6 and insert:
- "(B) If the judgment remedies for any monetary obligations in the judgment of conviction have expired under section 1 of this 2025 Act, the person shall be considered to have fully complied with or performed the sentence of the court with respect to those monetary obligations."
 - On page 6, delete lines 16 through 38 and insert:
- "SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
