**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3910**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “264.335” insert “and 264.336”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 16 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 264.335 is amended to read:

4 “264.335. In addition to the other powers granted to districts under this  
5 chapter, a district may exercise the powers granted to sanitary districts un-  
6 der ORS 450.005 to 450.245 [*when*] **if:**

7 “(1) The district obtains all or part of its supply of water from a  
8 watershed[;] **and:**

9 “[2] (a) The watershed is located in a sole-source aquifer designated  
10 prior to September 29, 1991, by the United States Environmental Protection  
11 Agency under the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300f et seq.);

12 “[3] (b) The watershed is recognized under rules of the Environmental  
13 Quality Commission as a watershed requiring protection from contamination  
14 in order to maintain high water quality; [*and*] **or**

15 “[4] (c) The district adopts a resolution declaring that the health of the  
16 residents of the district [*and*] **or** the general public interest requires the  
17 district to protect the water quality of the watershed[.]; **and**

18 **“(2) The district obtains written consent to its exercise of such**  
19 **powers from any sanitary district or other service provider that has**  
20 **been providing sanitary service to territory that will be served by the**  
21 **district pursuant to such exercise.**

1        **“SECTION 2.** ORS 264.336 is amended to read:

2        “264.336. Notwithstanding ORS 264.335, a district may exercise the powers  
3 granted to sanitary districts under ORS 450.005 to 450.245 if:

4        “(1) The district meets the requirements of ORS 264.335 (1), (3) and (4)  
5 **(2023 Edition)**;

6        “(2) Any part of the territory of the district is covered by the major dis-  
7 aster declaration related to wildfires requested by the Governor on Septem-  
8 ber 14, 2020, and approved by the President of the United States on  
9 September 15, 2020; and

10       “(3) The district is adjacent to a river that serves as a source of drinking  
11 water for a metropolitan area with a population greater than 100,000.”.

12       In line 17, delete “2” and insert “3”.
