**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2573**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 19 through 37 and insert:

2 “(4) The council shall:

3 “(a) Advise and make recommendations to the department on:

4 “(A) The criteria for the department to use to approve, reject or request
5 resubmission of pilot project proposals that the department determines sat-
6 isfy the requirements of subsection (2) of this section. The criteria must in-
7 clude, but are not limited to:

8 “(i) The effectiveness of the project in addressing the policy outcomes
9 described in subsection (2) of this section.

10 “(ii) The equity impact of the project, including how the project will
11 support older adults and people with disabilities.

12 “(iii) The prioritization of a project’s measurable outcomes and reporting
13 mechanisms.

14 “(iv) The availability of funds in the Quality Care Fund established under
15 ORS 443.001.

16 “(B) Minimum standards and data reporting requirements for pilot
17 projects funded through the program.

18 “(C) Other factors identified by the council as likely to facilitate suc-
19 cessful pilot projects.

20 “(b) Designate council members to participate in the deliberations on
21 proposals that the department determine satisfy the requirements of sub-

1 section (2) of this section.”.

2 On page 3, delete lines 17 through 23 and insert:

3 “(16) Notwithstanding subsection (4)(b) of this section, a member of the
4 council may not participate in deliberations on a proposal for a pilot project
5 if the member has a direct conflict of interest related to the pilot project.

6 “(17)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, within 90
7 days of the department approving a pilot project, the department shall, sub-
8 ject to available funds, allocate moneys to the pilot project from the Quality
9 Care Fund established under ORS 443.001.

10 “(b) The department may extend for a reasonable duration the 90-day
11 timeline under paragraph (a) of this subsection if the department determines
12 that an extension is reasonably necessary to accommodate the negotiation
13 of terms between the department and a pilot project.

14 “(18) The department each biennium shall allocate to pilot projects ap-
15 proved by the department up to one third of the total funds available in the
16 Quality Care Fund.”.
