**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3942**

1 Delete lines 5 through 26 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part**
3 **of ORS 441.015 to 441.119.**

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Health Authority, for health care fa-**
5 **cilities, except long term care facilities as defined in ORS 442.015, and**
6 **the Department of Human Services, for long term care facilities, shall**
7 **provide for an expedited licensure process.**

8 **“(2) A person or government unit shall be eligible to use the expe-**
9 **ditied licensure process to apply for a license to operate a health care**
10 **facility, if the license is to operate a health care facility in the same**
11 **physical location with no significant structural or functional changes**
12 **and of the same type as a health care facility that previously operated**
13 **at the location and the previously operated health care facility closed**
14 **within the last 24 months and was closed voluntarily or due to finan-**
15 **cial hardship.**

16 **“(3) Under the expedited licensure process:**

17 **“(a) An eligible applicant shall be issued a license to operate a**
18 **health care facility if:**

19 **“(A) The applicant currently operates a health care facility located**
20 **in this state that is of the same type as the health care facility for**
21 **which the applicant is applying for a license to operate;**

1 “(B) The applicant is in good standing under the laws and regu-
2 lations of this state;

3 “(C) There are no current or outstanding compliance issues at any
4 health care facility that the applicant operates located in this state;

5 “(D) Each licensed health care provider that works at a health care
6 facility that the applicant operates located in this state holds a license
7 that is in good standing; and

8 “(E) The health care facility for which the applicant is applying for
9 a license to operate is in compliance with all rules and regulations of
10 this state that apply to the health care facility.

11 “(b) A license shall be issued within 45 days after the date an ap-
12 plication is filed if the health care facility meets the criteria listed
13 under paragraph (a) of this subsection, unless a waiver is granted un-
14 der paragraph (c) of this subsection.

15 “(c) Waivers for construction and inspection requirements shall be
16 granted as appropriate.

17 “(4)(a) An applicant shall be issued a provisional license to operate
18 the health care facility while the applicant’s application is being pro-
19 cessed and reviewed under subsection (3) of this section, if the appli-
20 cant submits an attestation that the applicant and health care facility
21 meet all health and safety rules and regulations that apply to the
22 health care facility.

23 “(b) Prior to issuing a provisional license, the authority or depart-
24 ment shall conduct an in-person site inspection of the health care fa-
25 cility under ORS 441.025 (1).

26 “(c) The authority or department may prescribe by rule a fee to be
27 charged for a provisional license.

28 “(5) A license may not be issued under this section for a health care
29 facility if a certificate of need is required under ORS 442.315 and has
30 not been obtained.

1 **“SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
2 **date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative**
3 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
