**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2680**

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

“(a)(A) ‘Fenestration product or system’ means a window, glass, glazing or glazing system or skylight, whether installed in a horizontal or vertical plane, that is designed to provide a weatherproof barrier.

“(B) ‘Fenestration product or system’ does not include a premanufactured window or skylight.

“(b) ‘National certification’ means a certification that meets one of the following standards:

“(A) For glazing contractors, a certification that is in effect on the effective date of this 2025 Act and that Administrative Management Systems, Incorporated, or a successor organization, administers under the North American Contractor Certification program; or

“(B) For architectural glass and metal technicians, the Architectural Glass and Metal Technician national certification, as in effect on the effective date of this 2025 Act, that Administrative Management Systems, Incorporated, or a successor organization, administers.

“(c) ‘Public agency’ means the State of Oregon or a political subdivision of the State of Oregon or a county, city, district, authority, public corporation or public entity that is organized and exists under

1 a law or charter or an instrumentality of the county, city, district,
2 authority, public corporation or public entity.

3 “(d) ‘Public building’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
4 455.560.

5 “(e) ‘Public funds’ means funds of which an officer or employee of
6 a public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, has custody or control by
7 virtue of a legal right that the public body confers by law upon the
8 officer or employee to direct the collection, use or transfer of moneys
9 payable to, belonging to or collected for the public body.

10 “(2) A public agency that provides public funds to install, repair or
11 remodel a fenestration product or system in a public building that the
12 public agency constructs, remodels or repairs and owns or leases shall
13 require, as a condition of providing the public funds for the installa-
14 tion, repair or remodeling, that:

15 “(a) The contractor that installs, repairs or remodels the
16 fenestration product or system:

17 “(A) Has all licenses and insurance required to perform con-
18 struction work in this state; and

19 “(B) Has a national certification as a glazing contractor; and

20 “(b) One or more of the workers or technicians that provides the
21 labor for, or direct oversight of, the installation, repair or remodeling
22 has a national certification as an architectural glass and metal tech-
23 nician.

24 “(3) The requirement set forth in subsection (2) of this section ap-
25 plies to public buildings in which a public agency provides of \$25
26 million or more in public funds for new construction or \$5 million or
27 more in public funds for installing, repairing or remodeling, but not
28 for providing routine maintenance for, a fenestration product or sys-
29 tem in a public building that the public agency constructs, remodels
30 or repairs and owns or leases.

1 **“(4) A contractor that installs, repairs or remodels a fenestration**
2 **product or system in a public building described in subsection (3) of**
3 **this section, in addition to having a national certification as a glazing**
4 **contractor, must employ at least one worker or technician with a na-**
5 **tional certification as an architectural glass and metal technician.**

6 **“SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this 2025 Act is amended to read:

7 **“Sec. 1.** (1) As used in this section:

8 “(a)(A) ‘Fenestration product or system’ means a window, glass, glazing
9 or glazing system or skylight, whether installed in a horizontal or vertical
10 plane, that is designed to provide a weatherproof barrier.

11 “(B) ‘Fenestration product or system’ does not include a premanufactured
12 window or skylight.

13 “(b) ‘National certification’ means a certification that meets one of the
14 following standards:

15 “(A) For glazing contractors, a certification that is in effect on the ef-
16 fective date of this 2025 Act and that Administrative Management Systems,
17 Incorporated, or a successor organization, administers under the North
18 American Contractor Certification program; or

19 “(B) For architectural glass and metal technicians, the Architectural
20 Glass and Metal Technician national certification, as in effect on the effec-
21 tive date of this 2025 Act, that Administrative Management Systems, Incor-
22 porated, or a successor organization, administers.

23 “(c) ‘Public agency’ means the State of Oregon or a political subdivision
24 of the State of Oregon or a county, city, district, authority, public corpo-
25 ration or public entity that is organized and exists under a law or charter
26 or an instrumentality of the county, city, district, authority, public corpo-
27 ration or public entity.

28 “(d) ‘Public building’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 455.560.

29 “(e) ‘Public funds’ means funds of which an officer or employee of a public
30 body, as defined in ORS 174.109, has custody or control by virtue of a legal

1 right that the public body confers by law upon the officer or employee to
2 direct the collection, use or transfer of moneys payable to, belonging to or
3 collected for the public body.

4 “(2) A public agency that provides public funds to install, repair or re-
5 model a fenestration product or system in a public building that the public
6 agency constructs, remodels or repairs and owns or leases shall require, as
7 a condition of providing the public funds for the installation, repair or re-
8 modeling, that:

9 “(a) The contractor that installs, repairs or remodels the fenestration
10 product or system:

11 “(A) Has all licenses and insurance required to perform construction work
12 in this state; and

13 “(B) Has a national certification as a glazing contractor; and

14 “(b) One or more of the workers or technicians that provides the labor
15 for, or direct oversight of, the installation, repair or remodeling has a na-
16 tional certification as an architectural glass and metal technician.

17 “(3) The requirement set forth in subsection (2) of this section applies to
18 public buildings in which a public agency provides of \$25 million or more in
19 public funds for new construction or \$5 million or more in public funds for
20 installing, repairing or remodeling, but not for providing routine mainte-
21 nance for, a fenestration product or system in a public building that the
22 public agency constructs, remodels or repairs and owns or leases.

23 “(4) A contractor that installs, repairs or remodels a fenestration product
24 or system in a public building described in subsection (3) of this section, in
25 addition to having a national certification as a glazing contractor, must
26 *[employ at least one worker or technician with a national certification as an*
27 *architectural glass and metal technician]* **demonstrate to the public agency**
28 **as a condition of receiving public funds that at least 25 percent of the**
29 **contractor’s employees who install, repair or remodel fenestration**
30 **products or systems have a national certification as architectural glass**

1 and metal technicians.

2 **“SECTION 3.** (1) Section 1 of this 2025 Act becomes operative on
3 **July 1, 2027.**

4 **“(2) The amendments to section 1 of this 2025 Act by section 2 of**
5 **this 2025 Act become operative on July 1, 2028.**

6 **“SECTION 4. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
7 **date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative**
8 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
