**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2688**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 44 and 45.

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 12 and insert:

3 “(G)(i) Subject to sub-subparagraph (ii) of this subparagraph, bespoke,
4 off-site fabrication, preconstruction, assembly or construction work per-
5 formed specifically for, and in accordance with the specifications of, a par-
6 ticular project of a type listed in subparagraphs (A) to (F) of this paragraph,
7 for the following systems:

8 “(I) Mechanical systems such as heating, ventilation, air conditioning,
9 refrigeration and other ducting or piping systems or components;

10 “(II) Plumbing systems or components;

11 “(III) Electrical systems or components of electrical systems that conform
12 with the requirements of ORS 479.510 to 479.945 and the rules of the Elec-
13 trical and Elevator Board;

14 “(IV) Boiler systems or components of boiler systems;

15 “(V) Ornamental and structural iron work;

16 “(VI) Masonry and plaster systems or components;

17 “(VII) Roofing, flashing and architectural panel systems or components
18 other than glazing systems and components; and

19 “(VIII) Mechanical insulation work.

20 “(ii) The work described in sub-subparagraph (i) of this subparagraph is
21 a public works only if the commissioner or a contracting agency determines

1 that the work is performed at a site that is the site of the work, as defined
2 in 29 C.F.R. 5.2, as in effect as of the effective date of this 2025 Act.”.

3 In line 27, delete “January” and insert “July”.

4 Delete lines 28 through 35 and insert:

5 “(2)(a) The Attorney General, the Director of the Oregon Department of
6 Administrative Services, the Director of Transportation and a contracting
7 agency that adopts rules under ORS 279A.065 or 279A.070 may adopt rules
8 and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection
9 (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the Attorney General, the di-
10 rectors or the contracting agency to undertake and exercise all of the duties,
11 functions and powers conferred on the Attorney General, the directors or the
12 contracting agency by the amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1 of this
13 2025 Act.

14 “(b) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall adopt
15 rules that, among other items, specify which manufacturing and which
16 standard inventory items are excluded from the definition of public works
17 and the requirements for reporting off-site work, and may take any other
18 action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section
19 that is necessary to enable the commissioner to undertake and exercise all
20 of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the commissioner by the
21 amendments to ORS 279C.800 by section 1 of this 2025 Act.”.

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
