## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 178

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "discovery" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 4 through 28 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Justice shall conduct a study
5 on the establishment of a statewide uniform fee schedule for discovery
6 costs charged by district attorney offices.

"(2) The department shall conduct the study in consultation with
the Oregon District Attorneys Association and any other public or
private entity the department determines to have relevant or helpful
information on the subject.

11 "(3) In conducting the study, the department shall:

"(a) Take into account the costs incurred by district attorney of fices in providing discovery and maintaining a secure electronic file
 sharing system used to share discovery with other parties; and

15 "(b) Review public entities to determine the public entity best suited
 16 to receive appropriated funds for and reimburse discovery costs.

"(4) The department shall submit a report that includes a recommended fee schedule in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include additional recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2027. "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2,
 2028.".
