3 Delete lines 4 through 13 and insert:

"<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Any person who has been deprived of any rights,
privileges or immunities secured by Article I of the Oregon Constitution by a person acting under color of law may bring a civil action for
economic and noneconomic damages, as defined in ORS 31.705, and for
injunctive or other equitable relief.

9 "(2) ORS 30.260 to 30.300 apply to an action under this section.

"(3)(a) The court shall award reasonable attorney fees and costs to
 a prevailing plaintiff in an action under this section.

12 "(b) The court may award reasonable attorney fees and costs to a 13 prevailing defendant in an action under this section only if the court 14 determines that the plaintiff's claim under this section was frivolous, 15 unreasonable or without foundation.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act applies to deprivations of
 rights, privileges or immunities secured by Article I of the Oregon
 Constitution that occur on or after the effective date of this 2025 Act.
 "SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
 date on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.".
