PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1047

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "County" insert "; and declaring an emergency".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) On or before June 30, 2027, Curry County shall
- 5 expedite any applications for land use planning, building permits,
- 6 business licensing, public health or restaurant licensing, or any other
- 7 permit related to the operation or use of the land for any development
- 8 on lands within the county that are:
- 9 "(a) On a tract, as defined in ORS 215.010, that is larger than 125 acres; and
- 11 "(b) Sited north of the city limits of the City of Port Orford, west 12 of U.S. Highway 101 and south of the Elk River.
- 13 "(2) Curry County may discount or waive any fees required for 14 processing an application under subsection (1) of this section.
- "(3) Curry County may take any reasonable actions or pay any state, federal or other local fee to expedite the review of any application not within the control of the county for any development described in subsection (1) of this section.
- "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the

- General Fund, the amount of \$55,000, to disburse to Curry County to take actions authorized under section 1 of this 2025 Act.
- "SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Water Resources Department shall expedite the review of any application
- 5 for, or permit decision relating to, the development of a well or stor-
- 6 age on the lands described in section 1 (1) of this 2025 Act.

"SECTION 4. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage."
