**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1047**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “County” insert “; and declaring an
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. On or before June 30, 2027, Curry County shall expe-**
5 **dite any applications for land use planning, building permits, business**
6 **licensing, public health or restaurant licensing, or any other permit**
7 **related to the operation or use of the land for any development on**
8 **lands within the county that are:**

9 **“(1) On a tract, as defined in ORS 215.010, that is larger than 125**
10 **acres; and**

11 **“(2) Sited north of the city limits of the City of Port Orford, west**
12 **of U.S. Highway 101 and south of the Elk River.**

13 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
14 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
15 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the**
16 **General Fund, the amount of \$55,000, to disburse to Curry County to**
17 **take actions authorized under section 1 of this 2025 Act.**

18 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Wa-**
19 **ter Resources Department shall expedite the review of any complete**
20 **application or subsequent application decision related to the authori-**
21 **zation for the development and use of groundwater, including storage**

1 of groundwater, on the lands described in section 1 of this 2025 Act.
2 **SECTION 4.** This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate
3 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
4 declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
